

Safeguarding Commission

Nottingham Roman Catholic Diocese is seeking an independent lay person to chair the Diocesan Safeguarding Commission.

Candidates should have extensive and current professional safeguarding expertise and expertise in working with children and/or adults at risk. They will have a proven track record of working extensively at a senior level in related areas (eg. social care, police, probation or family law).

The successful candidate will also require an understanding of the Catholic Church and its structures in relation to safeguarding, and will need to be independent from the management hierarchy of the Diocese.

The Commission meets 4 times a year.

This is a voluntary role but expenses can be reimbursed.
